The OneStory Partnership Seminar in
Orality & Storying
and Cross-Language Storycrafting

Venue: Taman Lakeview, Cameron Highlands, Malaysia

Dates: 14-21 Nov. 2008

(sessions 9AM-5:30PM, no sessions on Sunday)

The training is an intense seven (7) day workshop designed for those who are already involved in ministry and want to learn to use this method. It is open to anyone, but requires a time commitment of the full seven days.

This training is open to those interested in learning about Bible storying, and is especially appropriate to cross cultural workers already involved in a people group or language group work.

This training is also appropriate to staff of various agencies or churches who desire to gain a greater familiarity with storying and orality as it is done in a OneStory approach. For more information on OneStory, please visit www.OneStory.org and explore the links.

This training is entirely oral and participatory, rather than using texts, handouts and lectures.

It models...

- * aspects of group storying that lead to reproducibility.
- * the storying of a worldview-sensitive redemptive panorama in fellowship groups.
- * involving mother-tongue speakers of receptor languages in cross-language story crafting and development of an oral redemptive panorama.

As a result of this training participants are prepared to engage in the beginning stages of story crafting with an unreached or under-reached people group or Bibleless language group.

During the session participants may explore, if interested, possible involvement in subsequent sessions and consultations by OneStory partners to support a storying project.

All participants should be able to understand and communicate in English, although it will not be the first language for everyone. If English is not your first language, please let us know so we can evaluate your fluency level prior to the workshop. Participants need to be comfortable enough in English to tell a 3-5 minute story in front of a group without any notes.

Participants are responsible for their own travel, lodging and meal expenses. There will be a fee of 350 RM (about \$100 US) per person, married couple or language team to help cover workshop costs. Advance registration is required. The registration deadline is Oct 1, 2008.
